The Hong Kong Institution of Engineering Surveyors application to become a member of FIG

Dear President Magel,

Our Institution is still sincerely hoping to become a member of the FIG to contribute ourselves to the International Geomatics Profession. The followings are some points for yourself and the other members of FIG to consider our application.

- FIG is the organization for the international surveyors, dispatch information and promote surveying that HKIES is also doing. We believed according to the FIG Congress in Seoul, our application was welcomed and our Institution can contribute ourselves to the Commission Six in all dimensions. If the refusal because of political reasons that will only damage the image of the FIG and does not help FIG in the future developing.
- In the FIG Washington DC Congress, HKIES was asked whether a Vote from the members for the application or a dialogue with the FIG senior officials with HKIS. HKIES did not want to embarrass FIG for Voting and accepted the solution of a Forum with HKIS within one year time to see whether both parties can find an agreement for either HKIES will sit in HKIS (like ICES and RICS) or carry on the application to FIG. But, HKIS did not follow what had been agreed in the FIG that they should arrange a forum with HKIES. The fact was HKIS was playing a game of words that they only asked individuals to brief them about the FIG. This fact was reported to the Head Quarter and the Senior Official who arranged the talk between HKIS and HKIES in Washington DC.
- HKIES is growing since the founding of the Institution and at the end of March 2006; we have 670 members in all grades. Moreover, there are 73 members of HKIES are also ICES members and 14 HKIES members are also China Society of Geodesy, Photogrammetry and Cartography (CSGPC) members and 45 HKIES members are also HKIS member. - HKIES is not lesser standing in HK. The Director of Surveying and Mapping of Lands Department Mr. Au Yeung Ping Kwong had stated that the HKIES, HKIS & Hong Kong Polytechnic University (HKPolyU) have been working together to promote the Geomatics in HK. HKIES, HKIS and HKPolyU have together organised many Geomatics Conferences over the past 10 years. Please refer to Appendix B1 to B3 for the recent years activities.


